Suggestions for the FY2022 Work Program special project:


- A. Municipal facility inspection checklists

Discussion on P2 Task Force Format Change

- With a strong interest in webinars and trainings as the special project for the work program, would the group be open to transitioning to a Roundtable format?

 - Intermediate/Advanced Dry Weather Field Screening Training will be held <u>July 27th from 9 AM- 3:30 PM Via MS Teams</u>.
- Regional Wet Weather Characterization Program (RWWCP)
 - RWWCP is in the fourth year of the program term.
 - Beginning phase of implementation of Best Management Practices Analysis and Evaluation Plan (BANEP).
 - All participants are collecting BMP data.


