3. **Subcommittee Project Discussion.** NCTCOG will present the status of current projects pertaining to On Site Sewage Facility (OSSF - Task 5.2) Education Efforts for Real Estate Agents, Property Inspectors, and Homeowners.

NCTCOG hosted a workshop for homeowners on July 25, 2019, in Burleson that included presentations from Ryan Gerlich, Texas A&M, and Becca Grassl-Petersen, Tarrant County, covering the basics of living with septic systems and the legal requirements for septic systems in Tarrant County. There were seven attendees and presentations are available online.

NCTCOG presented the draft OSSF educational brochure for homeowners. This brochure will be posted online with additional information for homeowners, including information on Designated Representatives in the North Central Texas region. NCTCOG will begin creating educational materials for home inspectors and real estate agents.

NCTCOG is currently coordinating with the Houston-Galveston Area Council to host an OSSF Workshop for Home Inspectors in early 2020. This training will require a site visit and will be free to attendees.
