The Task Force did not have any comments on the August 25, 2015 meeting summary.

### 3. Approval of the 2015 Annual Monitoring Report.

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) staff will brief the Regional Stormwater Monitoring Task Force (RSMTF) on the 2015 Annual Report for the RSMTF's approval and submission to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

The Task Force approved the 2015 Annual Monitoring Report with no comments. NCTCOG staff briefed the RSMTF on the edits that were made to the report after comments from the Task Force. NCTCOG noted that the report would be submitted to TCEQ by the end of the month.

### 4. Final Summary Report.

Atkins staff will brief the RSMTF on the Final Summary Report and will ask for input from the RSMTF. The Final Summary Report will be completed and given to the entities prior to the expiration of Atkins' contract on June 30, 2016.

NCTCOG staff reminded the RSMTF that Atkins would be completing a final summary report as a part of their contract. Atkins staff handed out a draft outline for the final report and discussed the outline with the RSMTF. Atkins noted that the final summary report will discuss each of the monitored sub-basins and may help entities make decisions regarding water quality of the sub-basins. NCTCOG staff requested that the RSMTF review the outline and send in comments or questions by March 18<sup>th</sup>.

### 5. Next Permit Term Planning.

NCTCOG staff will update the RSMTF on feedback received from the TCEQ on the schedule of the next permit term, and will update the RSMTF on the next steps in the permit term planning process.

NCTCOG staff briefed the RSMTF on the meeting with TCEQ that was held in December 2015, and discussed the schedule that has been suggested by TCEQ for the 4<sup>th</sup> permit

term. The RSTMF also discussed the schedule of the Regional Wet Weather Characterization Program (RWWCP) in comparison to the individual MS4 permit schedules of each entity. NCTCOG noted that the schedules are different, and that the RWWCP should continue on its projected schedule and entities will be given credit for monitoring done outside of their MS4 permit schedule.

NCTCOG reminded the RSMTF that the 4<sup>th</sup> permit term will focus on impaired waterbodies when selecting watersheds for monitoring. NCTCOG staff also noted that total coliforms will not be monitored during the 4<sup>th</sup> permit term and that carbaryl needs to be replaced. Fort Worth suggested that carbaryl be replaced with dieldrin.

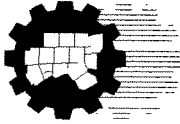

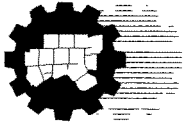
Entities had the opportunity to share community updates, but Task Force members did not have any updates to report.
