2021 MARCH IS TEXAS SMARTSCAPE MONTH

- Seeking input and feedback on suggested graphics for 2021 campaign
 - SmartScape landscaping with butterflies, birds, bees and other insects. Child examining a butterfly or bug.
 - Feature native grasses. Show diversity between "traditional" flowering options and native/adaptive grasses, highlighting how they help add texture, structure, and winter interest.
 - Beautiful residential landscape with home photos.
 - Prominently feature the coneflower.
 - Watercolor visuals of plants, showing common and scientific name as well as roots.
 - SmartScape plants not gulping water while non-SmartScape plants look like they are drinking lots of water.
 - Plants with legs marching towards a landscape area or people marching with SmartScape labeled plants toward a flower bed.

FY20 PROJECT UPDATE


- The North Texas Community Cleanup Challenge has been postponed until 2021

Results of the 2021 Doo the Right Thing Photo Contest

- 189 pledges and photo entries received
 - 172 eligible entries
 - Pledges from residents of >29 cities
- Entry period was open from July 1st through August 31st
- Voting period was open to PETF members via survey September 3rd through September 18th
- Received votes from 14 PETF members
- Began posting and using the new format October 1st, 2020.
