<u>Avian Feeding and Management:</u> NCTCOG presented the finalized social media toolkit to the subcommittee. The toolkit is available for download and use on the <u>NCTCOG TMDL website</u>.

<u>Feral Hog Management:</u> NCTCOG hosted the Feral Hog Forum on August 13, 2019 at NCTCOG Offices, with 23 attendees. The forum included presentations from Rachel Richter, Texas Parks and Wildlife, and Josh Helcel, Texas A&M Natural Resources Institute. The forum also included a roundtable session led by Adam Henry, US Department of Agriculture. The presentations from this forum are available on the <u>NCTCOG TMDL website</u>.

<u>Pet Waste:</u> NCTCOG presented the draft "Doo the Right Thing" social media toolkit. This toolkit is available for download and use on the <u>NCTCOG TMDL website</u>. Additionally, NCTCOG's Public Education Task Force is giving the Doo the Right Thing brand a total refresh, including new social media accounts and additional educational materials.

The subcommittee discussed potential future projects, including educational materials related to Strategy 3.0: Adoption of Green Infrastructure and Low Impact Development Standards by Municipalities, Strategy 3.2: Construction Sites, and Strategy 2.2: Land Use, Business, and Regulatory Review. NCTCOG will explore existing NCTCOG resources related to these strategies.

The City of Dallas has received their new permit and is working on their annual report. The City of Dallas will be starting wet and dry weather sampling in March 2020.

Park Cities MUD is currently pumping to combat zebra mussels, an exotic, invasive species.

Tarrant Regional Water District has permitted two dog parks along the Trinity River in Fort Worth and is working on a second railroad bridge.

The City of Irving is working on their annual report and is waiting for TCEQ to complete their new permit.

The City of Fort Worth is working on the Sycamore Creek Golf Course development.
