1. Welcome and Introductions.

Steve Massey, City of Allen and Chair of the Resource Conservation Council (RCC), welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Notification of Conflicts of Interest. Steve Massey, Chair of the Resource Conservation Council (RCC), will request RCC representatives with a potential conflict of interest relating to an agenda item to notify the RCC of the conflict of interest.

ACTION ITEMS

3. Meeting Summary. The October 18, 2018, meeting summary is available online for your review. Approval will be sought at the meeting.

Brenda Haney, City of Irving, made a motion to approve the October 18, 2018 meeting summary. Grace Darling, Arlington Conservation Council, seconded the motion. The RCC was unanimous in its approval.

4. Conformance Review Recommendation: Weatherford Transfer Station. Brenda Haney, City of Irving and Chair of the Conformance Review Subcommittee, will present the conformance review recommendation for RCC approval.

Brenda Haney, City of Irving and Chair of the Facility Conformance Subcommittee, provided an overview of the facility conformance review meeting held on February 5, 2019 regarding the registration application for the Waste Connections Weatherford Transfer Station. The subcommittee determined this registration application was in conformance with *Planning for Sustainable Materials Management in North Central Texas 2015-2040*. The RCC discussed the registration permit application and other questions, including discussion about the amount of waste the transfer station would accept according to the application versus the conditional use permit. Brenda Haney made a motion to accept the



recommendation of the subcommittee. Vince Hrabal, Republic Services, seconded the motion. The motion passed with one dissenting vote.

DISCUSSION

5. Volkswagen Settlement Update. NCTCOG's Transportation Department will update the RCC on the Texas Plan for the Volkswagen Settlement.

Nancy Luong, Air Quality Team of the NCTCOG Transportation Department, provided an overview of the Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust Texas allocations and funding distribution and additional details over TERP programs. For more information, please visit https://www.dfwcleancities.org/.

6. 86th **Texas Legislative Session Update**. NCTCOG will provide an update on bills of interest.

NCTCOG provided an overview of bills related to solid waste topics currently in the 86th Texas Legislative Session. The <u>Legislative Matrix</u> is available online for review, under <u>NCTCOG's Materials Management Resources webpage</u>. This matrix will be updated on a weekly basis.

7. Regional Recycling Survey and Educational Campaign. NCTCOG will update the RCC on the status of the Regional Recycling Survey and Educational Campaign.

NCTCOG held two workshops for the Regional Recycling Survey and Educational Campaign on January 23, 2019. At the MRF Acceptable Materials workshop, Burns and McDonnell presented the results from the Waste Characterization Study performed in October 2018 and the results from the MRF interviews. During the Educational Campaign Pre-Testing Focus Group workshop, The Recycling Partnership worked with attendees to brainstorm ways to personalize the "It's All You" campaign for the North Central Texas region. The next workshop for this project is scheduled for Monday, May 20, 2019 at NCTCOG offices.

8. Recycling Technical Assistance Project. NCTCOG will update the RCC on the status of the Recycling Technical Assistance Project.

NCTCOG provided an update on Cooperative Teamwork and Recycling Assistance's (CTRA) efforts in the North Central Texas region. CTRA has provided three cities with recycling technical assistance since October 2018. A survey was conducted in December 2018 and CTRA is continuing to follow up with additional entities whose survey responses indicated potential need for assistance.

9. SHARE Electronic Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Project. NCTCOG will update the RCC on the status of the SHARE projects.



A Request for Proposals (RFP) for electronic recyclers will be released in March 2019. After the Electronic Recycling contract(s) have been set, NCTCOG will begin working with the RCC on the Household Hazardous Waste SHARE project.

10. Illegal Dumping Training Update. NCTCOG will update the RCC on the Illegal Dumping Workshops.

NCTCOG provided an update on the Illegal Dumping Workshops, held in Fall 2018 and in February 2019. A total of seven workshops were held, four of which were full with waitlists. NCTCOG is coordinating with the NCTCOG Police Academy on the ability to offer TCOLE credits at future illegal dumping workshops.

11. Recycling Coordinator Roundtable. NCTCOG will discuss the next steps for transitioning the Regional Recycling Survey and Educational Campaign Advisory Group into the Recycling Coordinator Roundtable.

NCTCOG discussed the next steps for the Recycling Coordinator Roundtable. The RCC suggested the name be changed to the Recycle Roundtable in order to better capture the purpose of the group.
