There were no future agenda items offered.


10. **Roundtable Topics/Other Business**. RCC members and NCTCOG staff may share additional items of solid waste interest as time allows.

The City of Haltom City, in its partnership with Keep Texas Beautiful, used cardboard boxes to construct a courthouse sculpture which may be listed in the Guinness World Records. When the sculpture is deconstructed, some of the cardboard will be used by the City of Fort Worth for the Cowtown Santa.

It was noted that 1,600 homes in the City of Denton are powered by captured methane gas, and that the City of Fort Worth powers 80 percent of its wastewater treatment plant with captured methane gas.


