Action and Discussion Items

- 1. **Meeting Summary Approval:** The July 23, 2014 Meeting Summary was presented and Tad Heimburger motioned for approval and Muhammad Rafique seconded the motion.
- 2. 2014-2015 Recap and Technical Subcommittee Review: NCTCOG staff provided an overview of the program since the last Coordination Committee in July 2014. NCTCOG noted that two of the technical subcommittees wished to be merged into other existing committees; Public Education and Outreach wished to be incorporated into the Stormwater Public Education and Outreach Task Force under the Regional Stormwater Management Coordinating Council and Pets, Livestock, and Wildlife wished to be incorporated into either Stormwater or Public Education and Outreach Task Force.
- 3. **Committee Membership:** No Coordination committee members opposed reducing the number of technical subcommittees to three. Committee members wished to have a follow up email with both technical committee and coordination committee current rosters for review.
- 4. Vision 303(d) Project Update and I-Plan Addition Briefing: Joe Shelnutt from AgriLife presented the new Vision 303(d) initiatives. Dr. Larry Hauck briefed the committee on the addition of four TMDL bacteria impaired segments upstream of Mountain Creek Lake into the Implementation Plan.
- 5. Resolution to Support Addition of Mountain Creek Lake Tributary Segments and Addendum 1 to I-Plan: The Committee formally adopted a resolution in support of inclusion of the Mountain Creek Lake tributary segments into the I-Plan. The Coordination Committee approved Addendum 1 which authorized NCTCOG to administratively amend the I-Plan to include the Mountain Creek Lake impaired segments and complete associated technical updates. Ron Stein and Dania Grundmann from TCEQ provided an overview of TCEQ's role for supporting inclusion of the Mountain Creek Lak tributaries. Motion was made by Robert Berndt and was seconded by Michael Kazda.
- 6. Other Program Updates: NCTCOG updated Committee on the upcoming Public Works Round Up which includes presentations on SSO prevention and green infrastructure. NCTCOG made note of 23 iSWM meetings being held within the region with local city staff over the coming months. Discussion included ideas for FY2016 workshops with emphasis on SSO prevention.
