1.0	Wastewater treatment facility effluent limits	N/A
1.1	Evaluation of non-participants in Sanitary Sewer Overflow Initiative (SSOI) and Capacity Management, Operation, and Maintenance (C-MOM) programs	NCTCOG and the Wastewater Technical Subcommittee aim to engage non-participants through education and outreach.
1.2	Lift station evaluation	Lift station evaluation SOPs and design requirements are included in the TMDL BMP library.
