Flood Management Task Force Friday, August 28, 2015 9:30 AM, Regional Forum Room NCTCOG Offices, CPII 616 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, TX 76011

1. Welcome and introductions.

DISCUSSION/PRESENTATION/ACTION ITEMS

2. **Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Mapping of CDC Applications.** The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) staff will present progress towards an updated GIS CDC Application Tracking Map to the Flood Management Task Force (FMTF).

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the CDC Application Tracking Map and showed the interactive map to the subcommittee.

3. **FY2016 Trinity River COMMON VISION Work Program Final Draft.** NCTCOG staff will present the updated FY2016 work program and seek comments from the FMTF.

No additional comments were received regarding the FY2016 Work Program

4. **CDC Manual Update.** NCTCOG staff will provide an update on the 4th Edition of the CDC Manual.

NCTCOG provided an update on the 4th Edition of the CDC Manual and subcommittee members expressed that they had additional changes to the manual. NCTCOG staff agreed to incorporate these changes by the next meeting.

INFORMATION ITEMS

5. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region VI or US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Progress Updates on Model Consolidation and Georeferencing. FEMA or USACE staff will give an update on the status of the integration of the CDC model for a shared consolidated model across agencies. USACE or NCTCOG staff will also update the FMTF on ATLAS 14 funding and progress.

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USACE provided an update on Atlas 14 and the consolidated model. The subcommittee began a discussion on the consolidated model. FEMA also provided an update on the FEMA incorporation of the USACE CDC Model.

6. **COMMON VISION Floodplain Management Seminar.** The Seminar occurred at the NCTCOG Offices on August 6th, 2015. Presentation topics included Development in the Floodplain, Flood Warning Systems, and National Weather Service Resources. The next Seminar will be held in early 2016 and NCTCOG staff will be developing a better strategy to outreach to elected officials.

NCTCOG staff provided information on the preceding seminar and briefly discussed plans for the next Floodplain Management Seminar.

7. **Tarrant Regional Water District (TRWD) Update**. TRWD staff will update the FMTF on the Floodway Stakeholders Steering Committee

TRWD provided an update on the floodway Stakeholders Steering Committee and the Subcommittee began a discussion that included what the best science would be for determining future flows of floods.

8. Community Rating System (CRS) Webinars. Webinars which provide information on different topics within CRS have been hosted by NCTCOG and TFMA monthly as part of the development of a North Central Texas CRS Users Group. NCTCOG staff will update the FMTF on webinar attendance and future CRS Users Group opportunities.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the monthly CRS User Group Webinars.

9. **Cooperating Technical Partnership.** NCTCOG staff will provide an update on the Bear Creek Risk Assessment Project.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the Bear Creek Risk Assessment Project and noted that the survey process in Colleyville was ongoing. NCTCOG Staff also noted that a CTP meeting would be held in November after the FMTF meeting for the 5 local CTP's.

10. **Integrated Stormwater Management (iSWM) Program.** An update on iSWM activities will be provided by NCTCOG staff.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the Benefits of iSWM meetings that are being held throughout the region. We are currently on Meeting 7 and Meeting 8 is planned in the upcoming weeks at the City of Richardson.

11. **Flood Photo Collection.** NCTCOG staff will give an update on the status of the flood photo collection which can be accessed at www.nctcog.org/envir/flooding.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the ongoing effort to collect photos from the May flooding events that occurred in North Central Texas. Additionally, NCTCOG staff requested any other flood photos, video, or statistical information to be sent to NCTCOG.



12. **TFMA Conference.** The TFMA Fall Technical Summit will be held September 2-4 in Houston.

TFMA provided an update on the upcoming conference and also discussed the one-day event that will be held on November 9th.

13. **National Flood Insurance Program Training.** NCTCOG will be partnering again with FEMA and TFMA to host the FEMA L-273 4-day course and CFM exam. This class will be held November 30 – December 3, 2015 with the CFM Exam held on Friday, December 4, 2015. NCTCOG staff will brief the Task Force on registration.

NCTCOG staff provided an update on the upcoming NFIP training.




