1. Summary from last meeting

The meeting summary from the January 9, 2014 meeting was accepted as written.

2. Information for contact clearinghouse

Contact information for: Allen, Arlington, Carrollton, Celina, Fairview, Fort Worth, Frisco, Irving, Mansfield, McKinney, and Sachse, has been received. Project still needs contact information for other cities and non-traditional MS4s.

3. Follow up on app idea

With an update to an Adobe suite used by Environment and Development, NCTCOG does have the ability to do apps. However, the estimate on an app for reporting IDDEs is about 300 hours which is not feasible due to time and financial constraints. The Task Force might also want to discuss whether a regional app is appropriate for local reporting.

4. IDDE Field Investigation Guide review for bacteria information.

Potential changes to the field guide include:

- Page, 1, change to checklist to include materials for sampling bacteria and ice and ice chest.
- On page 3, including other potential sources SSOs, WWTF/POTWs, liquid waste haulers and port-o-lets, pump stations, homeless camps, dog parks, horse stables, zoos and petting farms, slaughter houses, dairy/milk processors, flea markets (those with food service and/or animals), and sewage processing centers.
- Page 12, under vegetation include vegetation near outfall *or manhole*.

5. Case studies

Case studies were presented by Burleson (in absentia), McKinney, and Richardson. For the July meeting, Dallas and Mansfield have committed to sharing case studies.

6. Industrial Inspector Workshop

No locations have yet been determined for a workshop, so a spring training is not an option. Mansfield, Richardson, Grand Prairie, and McKinney are looking into possible locations.
