




- WATER cost sharing members: \$80 per person, Non-cost-sharing members: \$140 per person

3. Regional Training Update


- Grease Interceptor Whisperer Training February 2020
 - Ken Louck, Interceptor Whisperer Consulting Service, LLC
 - Endura Grease Traps originally offered to sponsor training at no cost to WATER/NCTCOG, but are no longer able to do so
 - Cost of training would be \$140-\$160 (excluding cost for lunch and WATER discount)
 - Potential to incorporate regional site visits to demonstrate grease trap inspections conducted by different entities
