## FY2018/2019 Solid Waste Public Meeting Summary Monday, October 9, 2017 at 10:00 A.M. NCTCOG's Regional Forum Room

The following North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) staff were in attendance at the Solid Waste Public Meeting: Edith Marvin, Cassidy Campbell, Ryann Cline, and Hannah Allen.

NCTCOG staff gave an overview of the forthcoming Solid Waste Program for FY2018 and 2019. The total budget for FY2018 and FY2019 is \$2,198,474, (\$1,099,237 each fiscal year), with a total of \$1,319,084 allocated for implementation funds (\$659,542 each fiscal year). The minimum amount for an eligible local government project is \$15,000 and the maximum \$200,000. <u>There will also be a project type for regional collaborative projects (consisting of at least 3 eligible entities) which will have a minimum amount of \$125,000 and a maximum \$500,000.</u>

The NCTCOG's Environment and Development Department is charged with administrating the grants. The application will be available on NCTCOG's website <u>January 8, 2018</u>. Applications will be submitted electronically and all applicants are encouraged to carefully read the application documents. Application scoring will be as follows:

- Question: How does the Resource Conservation Council and NCTCOG staff decide the split between the NCTCOG Regional Coordination Budget (40% of total funding) and the Implementation Projects budget (60% of total funding)?
- Answer: NCTCOG has historically received 40% of the total funding to administer the implementation grants, provide support to local entities, facilitate workshops and trainings, and manage regional websites.
