1. Welcome and introductions.

The meeting began at 9:30 a.m. with introductions of all present.

- 3. **FY 2018 Work Program.** NCTCOG staff will solicit input for FY 2018 work program items. (Mia Brown)
 - a. Basic Dry Weather Field Screening Training. NCTCOG staff will solicit input for possible training dates, locations, and instructors from the Task Force

The Task Force expressed the desire to continue having the Basic training in June. The cities of Carrollton and Fort Worth volunteered to provide instructors. The City of Carrollton volunteered to host the training again, pending site availability and further input from members.

b. Industrial Inspectors Workshop. NCTCOG staff will solicit input for possible training dates, locations, and instructors from the Task Force

Mia Brown informed the Task Force that Peterbilt had volunteered their facility as a site for the mock inspection portion of the Industrial Inspectors workshop, and that she was still working out details with the environmental representative. The Task Force requested that the date for the training be scheduled in late March or early April. The cities of Carrollton and Arlington said they would look into providing case studies about their facilities where industrial inspections are performed. The City of Denton volunteered the Denton Airport as a classroom facility if the inspection is held at Peterbilt. The Task Force requested that, like the 2016 workshop, TCEQ and EPA staff be invited.

IDDE Field Investigation Guide.** NCTCOG staff will review the IDDE Field Investigation Guide with the Task Force to find needed changes and updates to the most recent 2011 version.

The City of Mansfield mentioned that TCEQ called to schedule a focused investigation for the good housekeeping minimum control measure. The City has two positions open: Environmental Education Specialist and Environmental Health Specialist. The City is also looking into putting together an on-site sewage facilities program.

The City of Frisco had a follow up on their May audit with the EPA.

The City of Arlington has a position for Environmental Compliance Officer opening soon.

The City of Fort Worth's Environmental Master Plan is out for public comment.
