



US 67 AT CHISHOLM TRAIL PARKWAY/NOLAN RIVER ROAD FUNDING PARTNERSHIP

BACKGROUND

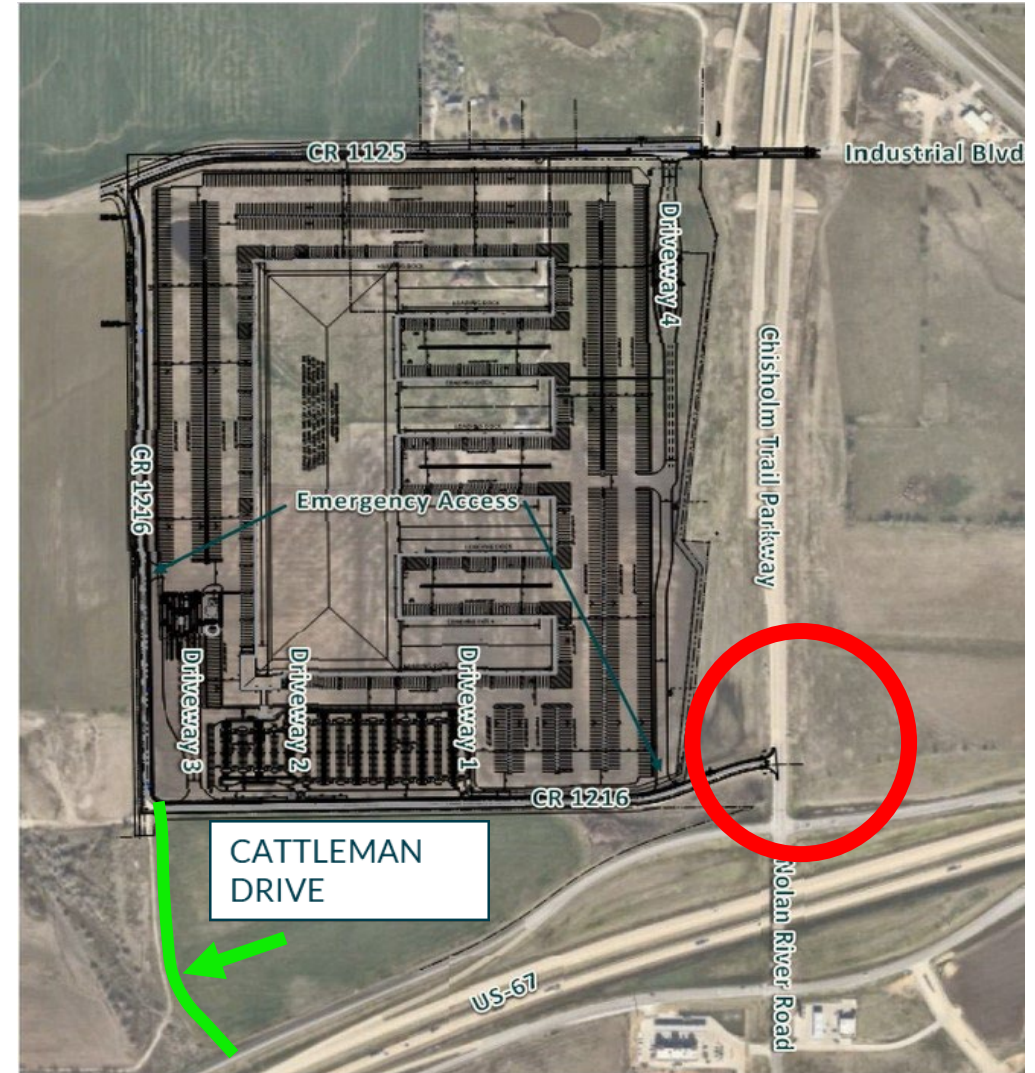
- The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Fort Worth District has requested funding assistance for improvements on Nolan River Road at US 67 where Chisholm Trail Parkway (CTP) terminates in Cleburne
- The two-lane roadway and bridge experience frequent congestion and half mile long queues, which will be further exacerbated once the widening of CTP to four lanes is complete in 2028



Southbound Chisholm Trail Parkway congestion on approach to US 67 interchange (NTTA)

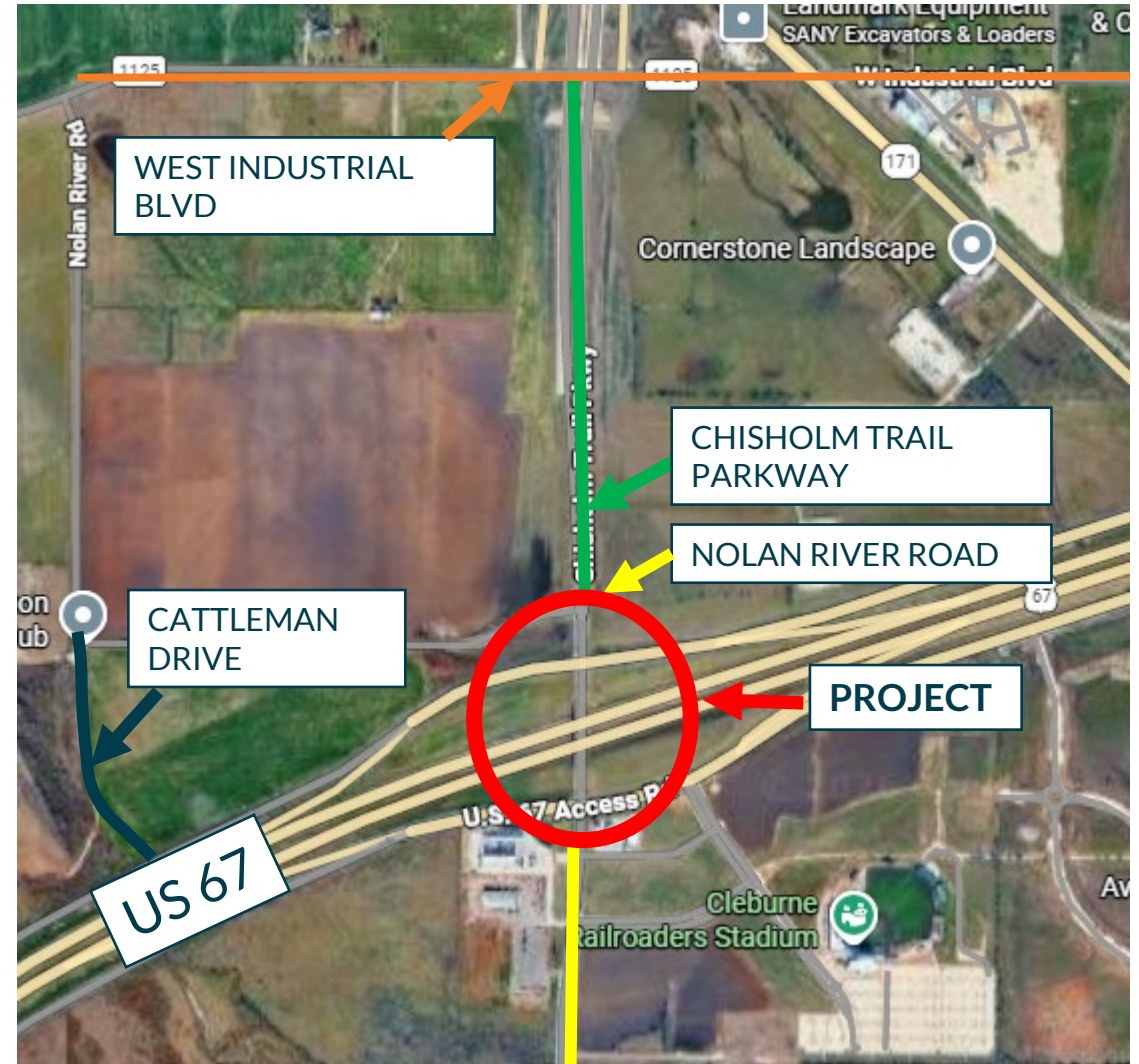
PREVIOUS INVESTMENTS IN THE AREA

- In September 2025, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC) provided funding assistance to the City of Cleburne to expedite the construction of a feeder road (Cattleman Drive) at the newly constructed Amazon facility near CTP and US 67
- The road provides truck traffic with direct access to the US 67 frontage road instead of using County Road 1216, which feeds directly into the CTP/Nolan River Road intersection
- Construction of Cattleman Drive was completed this summer



PROPOSED FUNDING PARTNERSHIP

- Proposed improvements include full reconstruction and widening of Nolan River Road from two to four lanes, which will address congestion, accessibility, and safety
- TxDOT-Fort Worth has funded both engineering and utility relocations, and is working to finalize the latter activities so that the project can go to construction in June 2027
- Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) staff recommend that construction be funded with \$12 million of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) and Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds (TxDOT would cover the match of \$3 million) for a total construction cost of \$15 million
