- Through regional collaboration and technical guidance, iSWM promotes sustainable development practices that protect people, property, and natural resources while helping communities meet state and federal requirements.

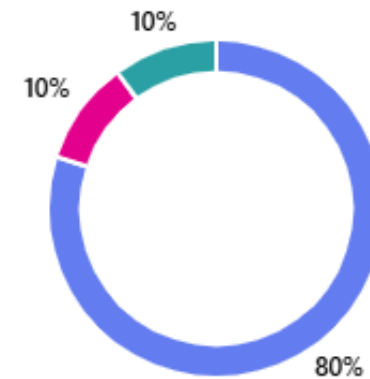

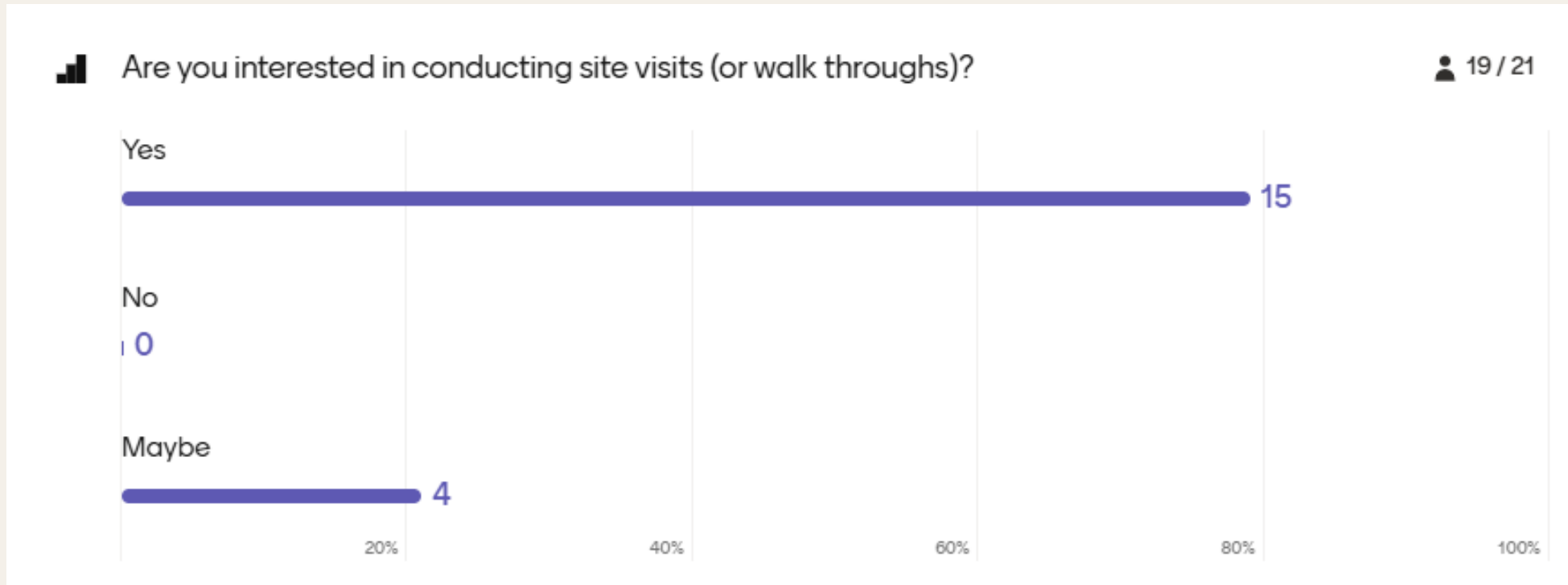
Fiscal Year 2027 Work Plan

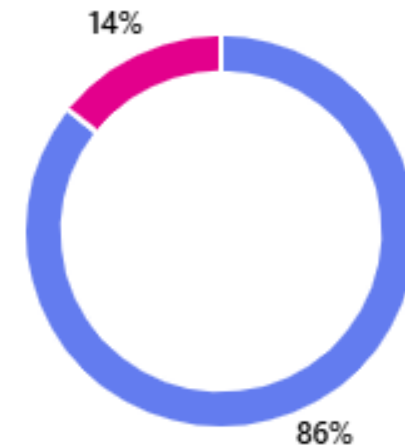
- Based on the June 3, 2026, meeting and participant interaction the task force selected the following deliverables as items of interest:

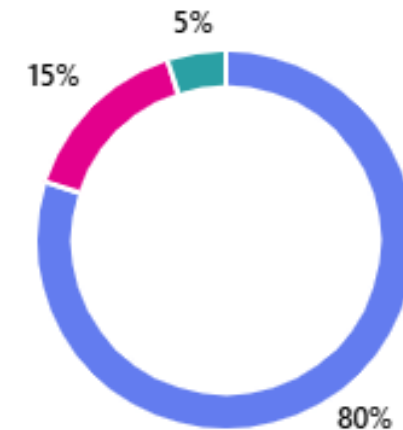

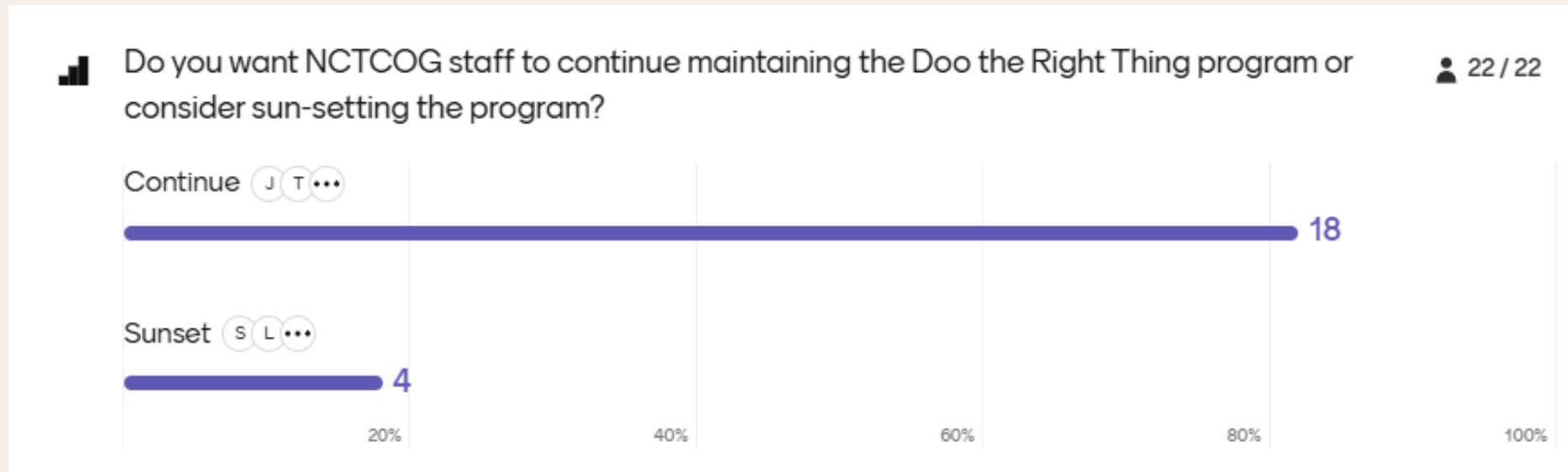

 - Conduct a workshop/ training the Texas Stream Team. Ideally, a Standard Core training or an E. coli Bacteria training.

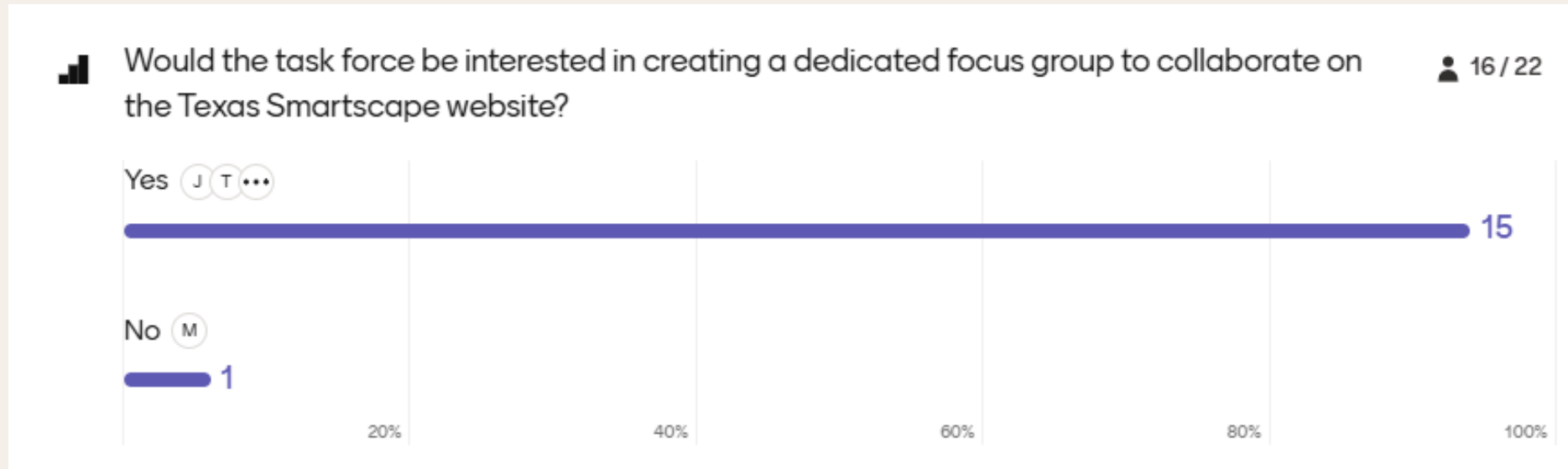
