4. **Approval of the 2026 National Electrical Code Regional Recommended Amendments (James Hathorn).** The Electrical Advisory Board (EAB) has completed the review of the 2026 National Electrical Code (NEC) and has developed [regional recommended amendments](#) for which the EAB will be seeking approval from the Regional Codes Coordinating Committee (RCCC).

Attendees discussed amendments to the 2026 National Electrical Code.

The motion brought forward by the Electrical Advisory Board to approve the National Electrical Code Amendments with no changes was approved unanimously.

5. **Approval of 2024 International Energy Conservation Code Special Amendment (Wayne Snell).** The Energy and Green Advisory Board (EGAB) has developed [a special amendment](#) to the 2024 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) to address simulated building performance compliance for which the EGAB will be seeking approval from the Regional Codes Coordinating Committee (RCCC).

Attendees discussed a special amendment to the 2024 International Energy Conservation Code.

The motion brought forward by the Energy and Green Advisory Board to approve the International Energy Conservation Code Special Amendment with no changes was approved with Bahman Yazdani, Texas A&M Energy Systems Laboratory, abstaining.

Another meeting of the Work Program Task force will be scheduled following the April Regional Codes Coordinating Committee Meeting, and a draft of the RCCC Bylaws will be provided to the RCCC at their July 28, 2026 meeting.
