

North Texas Zero Emission Vehicles Call for Projects

Existing Vehicle to Be Replaced Requirements	New Vehicle Requirements
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a Class 6 or 7 vehicle (i.e., Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) of 19,501 to 33,000 lbs) • Be an Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) vehicle (e.g., diesel, gasoline, propane, natural gas) • Be a Vocational Vehicle (e.g., box truck, step van, dump truck, transit bus, flatbed truck, refuse hauler, street sweeper, utility truck, etc.) • Operates at least 7,000 miles/year or idled for at least 500 hours/year during the prior 24 months (<i>multiple vehicles can be combined</i>) • Operates primarily in the NCTCOG 16-County region 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a Class 6 or 7 vehicle (i.e., GVWR of 19,501 to 33,000 lbs (<i>2,000 lb weight exemption for battery-electric</i>)) • Be a battery-electric or hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicle • Be a Vocational Vehicle • Be a Model Year 2023 or newer • Be owned by the applicant • Be similar in form and function to the existing vehicle to be replaced (<i>in terms of vehicle type, usage, and area of operations</i>)

Ineligible Activities:

- Fleet expansions
- Hybrid or Off-road vehicles
- Class 5 or Class 8 vehicles
- Leases
- Engine replacement/repower
- Stacking of funding
- Vehicles used for demonstration
- Funding only for infrastructure
