Gateway Drive Transfer Station

► Background:

- The North Texas Municipal Water District provides water, wastewater, and solid waste management to more than two million people in the North Texas region.
- The NTMWD is proposing a transfer station via permit application in Collin County to better serve residents in the five Regional Solid Waste System Member Cities and surrounding areas.

► Location:

- 0.65 miles East of Dallas North Tollway, 0.2 miles South of the intersection of PGA Parkway and Gateway Drive.

➤ Consistent with following regional goals:

➤ Facility Conformance Subcommittee Recommendation:

- The subcommittee voted unanimously to recommend this project to the RCC as conforming with the NCTCOG Regional Solid Waste Management Plan. Kathy Fonville, North Texas Municipal Water District, abstained.

Dick Price Road Transfer Station

➤ Background:

- Texas Regional Landfill Company, LP, is an affiliate of Waste Connections.
- WC provides collection, hauling, transfer, diversion/recycling, and disposal services throughout Texas, and owns and/or operates thirteen transfer stations in Texas.
- WC is proposing a transfer station in Tarrant County to better serve the residents of Fort Worth, Kennedale, and surrounding areas.

➤ Location:

- 4144 Dick Price Road, Fort Worth, TX

Dick Price Road Transfer Station

➤ Consistent with following regional goals:

- Support Materials Management Education & Training
- Promote Creation & Expansion of Waste Management Programs
- Promote Public & Private Sector Partnerships

➤ Facility Conformance Subcommittee Recommendation:

- The subcommittee voted unanimously to recommend this project to the RCC as conforming with the NCTCOG Regional Solid Waste Management Plan.

Conformance Review Recommendation: Permit Application, WC Weatherford Transfer Station, Parker County.

WC Weatherford Transfer Station

➤ Background:

- Waste Connections Lone Star, Inc., affiliate of Waste Connections, currently operates a registered Type V Transfer Station in Parker County, since 2019.
- A Type V permit application was submitted to TCEQ in May 2025 to remove the requirement to recover 10% of incoming waste for recycling or re-use.
- No change in waste type, waste throughput, or operating hours, only removing language regarding recycling.

➤ Location:

- The facility is located at 3131 Old Brock Road, Weatherford, TX.
- It is currently the only transfer station in Parker County.

WC Weatherford Transfer Station

➤ Consistent with following regional goals:

- Provide ample and convenient collection and disposal options in rural and underserved areas, including the establishment and expansion of transfer stations and citizen collection stations.
- This permit conforms to the identified goal of the plan; however; by upgrading the Registration to a Permit, the facility is no longer in conformance with goals related to recycling and landfill diversion.

➤ Facility Conformance Subcommittee Recommendation:

- The subcommittee voted unanimously to recommend this project to the RCC as conforming with the NCTCOG Regional Solid Waste Management Plan.

➤ Background:

- SouthWaste is a full-service liquid management company founded in 1948 and based in Houston, Texas. They are part of the Waste Resource Management (WRM) family of companies.
- SouthWaste is proposing a disposal facility to accept industrial waste and special waste.

➤ Location:

- 525 S 6th Ave, Mansfield, TX
