 - Reviewed the roster and population brackets
 - Nominations for the council will be accepted October 6-November 7
 - Nominations will be voted on at the December 4 meeting and the Executive Board will finalize
 - The available positions were reviewed

- 2025 SHSP Update Justin Cox, NCTCOG
 - Funding for FY25 SHSP was reviewed
 - \$500,000 for state/local capabilities to detect/monitor unmanned aircraft systems
 - \$625,000,000 for security/other costs for the 2026 FIFA World Cup
 - \$1,000,000,000 for security/planning for 2028 Olympics
 - \$450,000,000 – Operation Stonegarden
 - National Priority Areas
 - 30% spending requirement
 - Enhancing the protection of soft targets/crowded places
 - Enhancing cybersecurity
 - Supporting Homeland Security Task Forces and Fusion Centers
 - Enhancing Election Security
 - Supporting Border Crisis and Response Funding Opportunity
 - Requests for funding projects are due by October 10

 - Reviewed the calendar August 2025 – February 2026

- SHSP Grants Dashboard Justin Cox, NCTCOG
 - Reviewed the status of 2023 Interop, Pub Ed, Metro X, 2024 PWERT, 2024 SWAT, 2024 EOD
 - Most are spent or will be spent, 2023 Interop is requesting and extension to spend rest on travel in November
 - The 2025 applications will be delayed and won't get projects until January 2026
