NCTCOG staff facilitated a discussion regarding the future of the task force and sought guidance for developing the FY27 Work Program. NCTCOG staff initiated the conversation using comments submitted through the Whiteboard, which was displayed for all attendees.

A representative from the City of Fort Worth noted that a previous meeting discussion about creating a communication platform where stormwater professionals could connect and collaborate with peers facing similar challenges. Representatives from the City of Irving and the City of Burleson expressed support for this idea. NCTCOG staff stated that they would explore options for establishing a secure communication channel for external agencies.

A representative from TRA expressed interest in continuing to host guest speakers similar to the presentation provided at this meeting. The representative also suggested inviting TCEQ to provide spill response training or a related presentation. A representative from Lewisville requested additional resources and guidance regarding standard operating procedures (SOPs) for spill response.
