SUBJECT: Request for Proposals for Training Sessions for Bicycle and Pedestrian Design

Guides and Safe Routes to School Planning

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is requesting proposals from consultants interested in conducting Bicycle and Pedestrian Design Guides and Safe Routes to School Planning training sessions, which may include, but are not limited to the following:

1. American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities, 5th Edition.

 National Association of City Transportation Officials (NACTO) Urban Bikeway Design Guide, 3rd Edition.

3. Public Right-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) published in 2023.

4. Safe Routes to School planning and project implementation, including best practices, programs, projects, and policies.

This is an invitation to respond to the Request for Proposals (RFP). Proposers must submit one hard copy or one flash drive of the submission to Kevin Kokes, Program Manager, Land Use and Mobility Options, North Central Texas Council of Governments, 616 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, Texas 76011. Flash drives that are unreadable or contain corrupted files will be considered non-responsive. Proposals must be received by 5:00 pm, Central Time, on Friday, January 9, 2026. Proposals after that time will not be considered and will be returned unopened. The in-hand submittal will count as the official submittal.

In addition to the in-hand submittal, as NCTCOG is testing a new e-procurement system, NCTCOG will be releasing this RFP through the Bidnet Direct system and will accept electronic submissions through the system. A Bidnet Direct link will be included when the RFP is published. Proposers are encouraged to submit a courtesy response in Bidnet Direct to help familiarize themselves and NCTCOG staff with the system. If only a Bidnet Direct submittal is received, it will not be evaluated. The RFP will be available at www.nctcog.org/rfp by the close of business on Friday, December 12, 2025.

Any amendments or updates to the RFP, as well as all questions and responses, will be posted on NCTCOG's website. Written questions concerning the RFP should be submitted by email to TransRFPs@nctcog.org by 5:00 pm, Central Time, on Friday, December 19, 2025. We appreciate your consideration of this request.
