1. Welcome and Introductions.

2. Notification of Conflicts of Interest. Steve Massey, Chair of the Resource Conservation Council (RCC), will request RCC representatives with a potential conflict of interest relating to an agenda item to notify the RCC of the conflict of interest.

ACTION ITEMS

3. Meeting Summary. The November 12, 2020 meeting summary will be presented for approval.

Tiana Svenson (City of Garland) made a motion and Grace Darling (Arlington Conservation Council) seconded the motion to approve the November 12, 2020 meeting minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

4. FY22-23 Solid Waste Grant Program – Grant Application Guidelines and Call for Projects Timeline. Kathy Fonville, Vice Chair, will present the Grant Selection Subcommittee's recommended Grant Application Guidelines and Call for Projects Timeline to the RCC for approval. Additionally, the RCC will discuss topics and budgets for FY22-23 regional projects.

A motion to approve the grant application guidelines and call for projects timeline was made by Kathy Fonville. Dustin Deel (City of Weatherford) seconded the motion, which then passed unanimously.

Cassidy Campbell (NCTCOG) provided an overview of potential regional project topics discussed by the Grant Selection Subcommittee. The priority topics recommended by the Grant Selection Subcommittee include organic waste, waste disposal capacity and recycling. Additionally, the Grant Selection Subcommittee recommends not funding another waste characterization assessment at this time. After discussing the Subcommittee's recommendations, the RCC added tires to the list of topics for a potential regional project to

address. The Regional Management Plan Subcommittee will meet in April 2021 and provide additional recommendations to the RCC in May 2021 for consideration.

PRESENTATION

5. Third Waste Characterization Assessment Results. Burns and McDonnell, Inc. will present the results of the October 2020 waste characterization assessment that was performed in association with the Regional Recycling Survey and Education Campaign.

Scott Pasternak and Eric Weiss (Burns and McDonnell) presented on the waste characterization study methodology, outcomes, and year-over-year trends.

DISCUSSION

6. 87th Texas Legislative Session. NCTCOG will provide an update on bills of interest.

Hannah Allen (NCTCOG) provided an update on bills of interest for the 87th Texas Legislature. The legislative matrix can be found online <u>here</u>.

HB 753: Has major implications for local governments and franchising of solid waste pickup. NCTCOG will investigate if the bill only relates to commercial or if it includes cities and counties.

HB 914: Primary focus seems to be code enforcement and does not appear to have illegal dumping implications. Committee has requested Hannah Allen review the bill and determine if it should be removed from the matrix.

SB 1276: relates to public health improvement and pollution reduction through recycling incentives; assessing a fee. More information was requested by multiple participants on the call on information such as equity, financing, and how it relates to existing legislation.

7. NCTCOG Updates. NCTCOG will update the RCC on items of interest.


and other organics from landfills. The next step is to establish and convene an advisory group of diverse stakeholders to help guide the study.
