


FY25 Vice Chair Nomination

- Nominations by the Executive Committee for Vice Chair of the Regional Stormwater Management Coordinating Council have been accepted.
 - Vice Chair nomination: Jeff Shiflet, Stormwater Compliance Coordinator, City of Irving
- Procedures require that the Vice Chair alternate between a Phase 1 and a Phase 2 city. Nominees for FY24 are from a Phase II entity.
- Vice Chair is a 3-year commitment (Vice Chair, Chair, Past Chair) on the Executive Committee.
- Committee Procedures do not limit the number of terms a person or entity may serve.
- Voting for the Vice Chair will be done electronically. Staff will announce when voting has started, and the results.




Q4 If you answered yes to the question above, please select which audiences that you anticipate targeting. (select all that apply)


Q6 As part of MCM 1 - Public Education and Outreach, which pollutants and sources do you plan to address? (select all that apply)


Q8 What activities/BMPs are you planning to implement to address MCM 2 - Public Involvement/Participation? (select all that apply)


