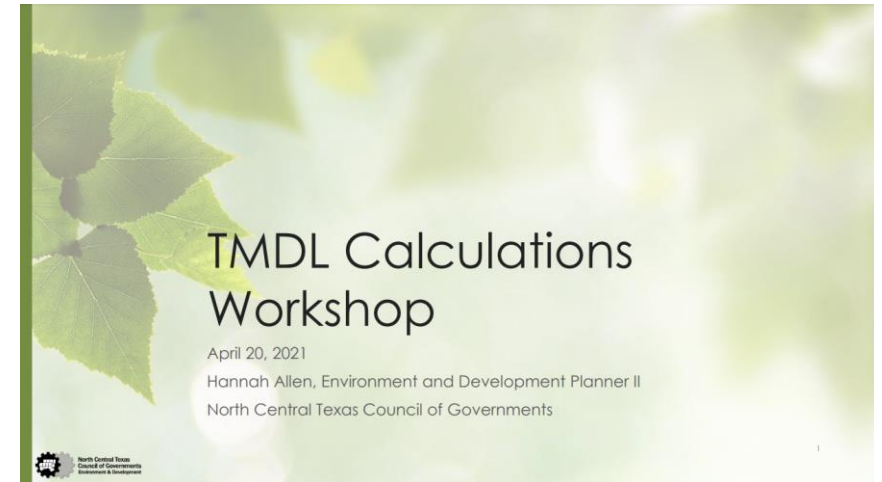

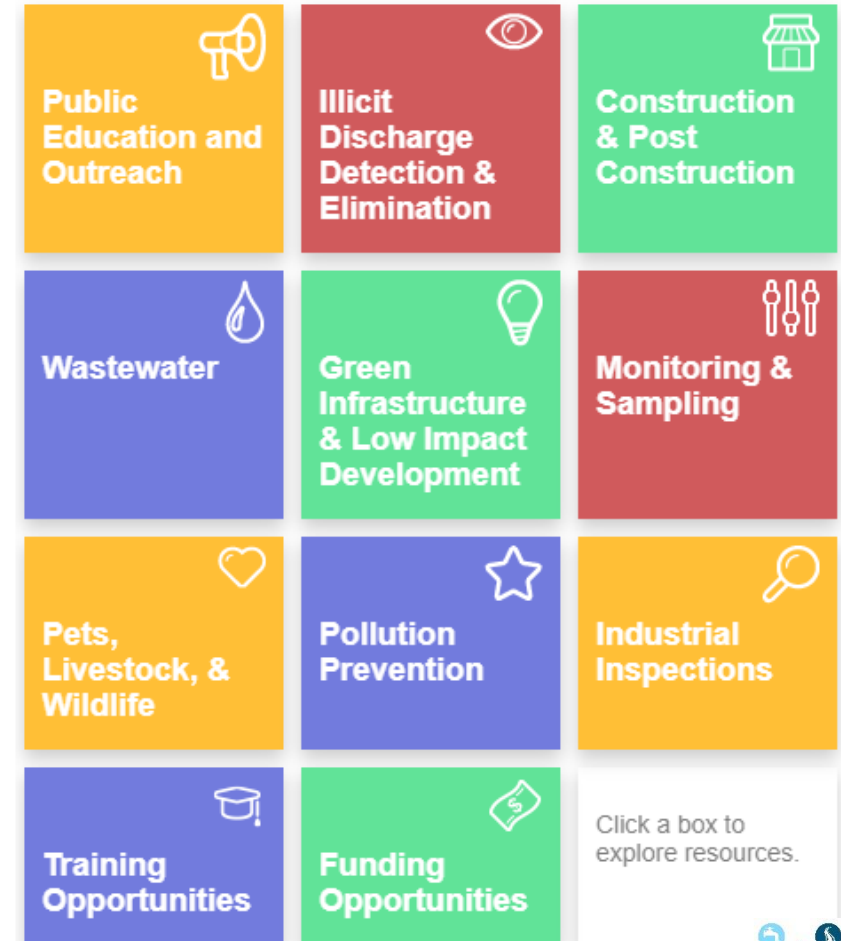
## 5. TMDL Program Activities Update

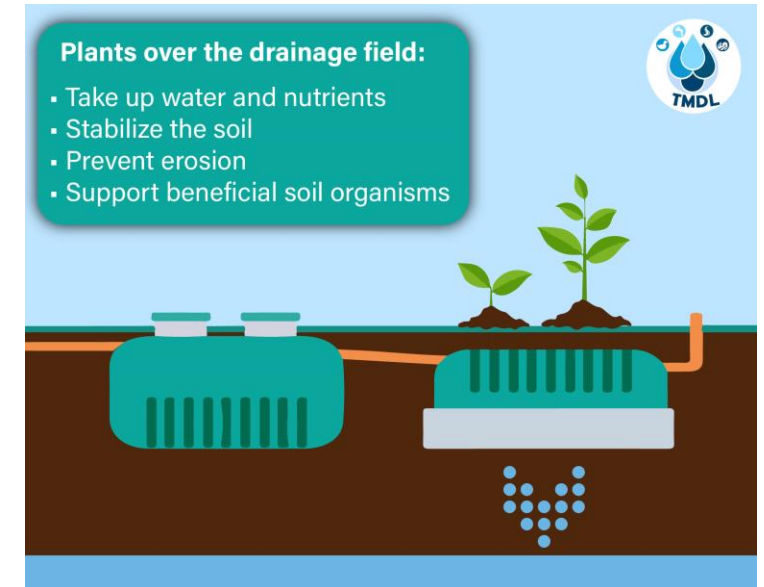
- Stormwater Technical Subcommittee
