Station controllers- this person will need to be able to explain fully what they supposed to be doing.

Possibly only 1 MRC team will be able to participate. They may be rotated into other CERT teams.

Minimize the number of CERT members that are victims so more active CERT members can participate.

About 100 victims are needed. James Knighton has CPR dummies that can be used for victims. Brenda asked about having junior ROTC members as victims, is there an age limit? Does under 18 need a parent. Candice- 16 is the minimum without a parent. 14 with a parent.

Jeremy- McKinney uses 12yrs as age to be able to use scout groups. Brenda: also allows those groups to earn their badges. Candice- Everyone will need to bring their own PPE. Part of the training is to have your own PPE.

2022 Project Discussion

Competitive grant structure, we are competing with other regional programs such as SWAT. We do not have to provide for Candice's' position through this grant.

Task booklets have been taken off the project list.

Moulage Training- you become a regional asset to assist with drills. \$6000 for training for 15 individuals

Portable Fire Pan- propane flow in water controlled in a wheelbarrow type container.

Does use real extinguishers. Ignition and flame can be controlled. \$25,000 An additional training will be offered to use the pan and the program would be responsible for their own propane and extinguishers. Will put in for 6 of them and spread them around the region for programs to borrow. From Hylcon PassFire Burn Pan is the product that is being considered.

Travel for 2 chairs and CCP coordinator to attend national CERT Conference. \$6,300

Supplies \$1000

Grant is due on Friday, total project total \$30,000.
