SUBJECT: Request for Proposals for Flooded Roads Information System Project

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is requesting proposals from consultants to develop a flood warning system for transportation facilities in the Dallas-Fort Worth region to identify potential flooding risk areas and alert the public about potentially dangerous conditions and closed roads. The study will assess existing and historical data collection, model the data to predict roadway flooding, and disseminate the results. The anticipated result will be a software to predict where flooding events of the transportation system would occur and a method to warn the public of the anticipated flooded areas.

This is an invitation to respond to the Request for Proposals (RFP). Proposers must submit one hard copy or one flash drive of the submission to Nathan Drozd, Principal Transportation Planner, 616 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, Texas 76011. Flash drives that are unreadable or contain corrupted files will be considered non-responsive. **Proposals must be received by 5:00 pm, Central Time, on Friday, February 28, 2025**. Proposals after that time will not be considered and will be returned unopened. <u>The in-hand submittal will count as the official submittal</u>. In addition to the in-hand submittal, NCTCOG is requesting electronic submission of proposals to <u>TransRFPs@nctcog.org</u>. Electronic submissions only will <u>not</u> be evaluated. The RFP will be available at <u>www.nctcog.org/rfp</u> by the close of business on **Friday, January 31, 2025**.

A Pre-Proposal Conference will be held at **1:00 pm on Monday, February 10, 2025**. Details regarding room and online options will be posted on the website. NCTCOG will accept written questions submitted by email to <u>TransRFPs@nctcog.org</u> in advance of the Pre-Proposal Conference. Written questions concerning the RFP should be submitted by **5:00 pm, Central Time, on Friday, February 7, 2025**. Any amendments or updates to the RFP, as well as all questions and responses, will be posted on NCTCOG's website. We appreciate your consideration of this request.
