




NCTCOG's PEOPLE MOVER INITIATIVE

- DFWIA Arlington Entertainment District UTA Connector



- ❖ How do we maintain a high quality of life / livability and attract businesses when we continuously have to accommodate this type of growth?


Improving Funding for Mobility Improvements




PROPOSED MIDTOWN ATS REGIONAL CONNECTIVITY


