# What is the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)?



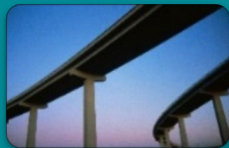
Represents a Blueprint for the Region's Multimodal Transportation System



Covers at Least a 20-Year Timeframe



Responds to Goals



Identifies Policies, Programs, and Projects for Continued Development



Guides the Expenditure of Federal and State Funds

# Mobility 2045 Goals

## Mobility

- Improve transportation options
- Support travel efficiency strategies
- Ensure community access to system and process

## Quality of Life

- Enhance environment and lifestyles
- Encourage sustainable development

## System Sustainability

- Ensure adequate maintenance, safety, and reliability
- Pursue long-term, sustainable financial resources

## Implementation

- Provide timely planning and implementation
- Develop cost effective projects and programs

# What is the MTP Policy Bundle?



Construction of infrastructure alone cannot achieve the goals of Mobility 2045



Local agencies voluntarily adopt policies from the Mobility Plan to help achieve goals like improving air quality, sustainable development



Agencies who apply may Receive Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) to help fund projects

# Actions Agencies Can Take

DIFFICULTY

## JOINT STAFF COORDINATION



RTC staff and local agency staff coordination.

## GOVERNING BODY APPROVAL



Resolution, court order, minute order, or other instrument.

## ORDINANCE



Ordinance or other locally enforceable rule or law.

## ELECTION



An election is held to implement the measure.
