Per CJPDC Policies and Procedures, Section 4.3.1: <i>Units of Local Government, ISDs, Native American tribes, Councils of Governments, State Agencies, Colleges and Universities have a suggested cap of \$100,000 for new or renewal JAG applications being scored and prioritized that benefit one (1) service area/jurisdiction; a suggested cap of \$160,000 on new or renewal JAG collaborative applications being scored and prioritized that benefit two (2) service areas/jurisdictions; and a suggested cap of \$240,000 on new or renewal JAG collaborative applications being scored and prioritized that benefit three (3) or more service areas/jurisdictions.</i> Applicants had to note if proposed project was a collaboration. Collaborative projects required submittal of Letters of Intent and applicable cooperative working agreements/MOUs.
