# FY22 Special Project Update

Non-structural Stormwater BMPs can be broken into several categories:

- Public Education
  - *Outreach and education campaigns, etc.*
- Planning and Management of Developing Areas
  - *Site design, vegetation control, green roofs, LID, etc.*
- Materials Management
  - *Housekeeping practices*
- Street/Storm Drain Maintenance
  - *Street cleaning, road/bridge maintenance, stormdrain maintenance, storm channel/creek maintenance, etc.*
- Spill Prevention and Cleanup
- Illegal Dumping Controls
  - *Stormdrain markers, HHW collection, used oil recycling*
- Illicit Connection Controls
  - *IDDE programs, failing septic systems and SSOs*
- Stormwater Reuse

- Dredging materials
- Street sweeping materials


