



**North Central Texas Clean School Bus Program**  
**Call for Projects**  
**Summary of Awarded Projects**



Since 2006, the North Central Texas (NCT) Clean School Bus Program has awarded more than \$2.7 million to Independent School Districts (ISDs), schools, and school bus operators in the North Central Texas Council of Governments 16-county service area. Funds have been awarded through a competitive Call For Projects with a goal of reducing emissions from older, high-polluting school bus fleets. Eligible activities include school bus replacement, engine repower, engine/exhaust system retrofits, and on-board idle reduction technologies that result in a reduction of NO<sub>x</sub> emissions.
