Featured TMDL Implementation Strategy: 5.2 OSSF Education Efforts for Real Estate Agents, Property Inspectors, and Homeowners

On Site Sewage Facilities (OSSFs), or septic systems, are small scale wastewater treatment systems that can adversely impact the environment and user if they are not maintained properly. The purpose of Implementation Strategy 5.2 is for the TMDL Coordination Committee and Wastewater Technical Subcommittee to educate homeowners, real estate agents, and home inspectors on proper OSSF maintenance and the consequences of failing OSSFs.

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is coordinating an OSSF Training for Homeowners in July 2019. This training will include a presentation from Ryan Gerlich, Texas A&M University, on the basics of living with a septic system, and a presentation from Becca GrassI-Petersen, Tarrant County, on the specific legal requirements for OSSFs in Tarrant County. More information about this workshop will be made available in the coming weeks.

In addition to this learning opportunity, the National Association of Wastewater Technicians (NAWT) is hosting a Septic System Inspectors Course September 13 - 14, 2019 in Arlington. This two-day long training that cover the basics of sewage treatment and system types along with a step-by-step procedure to conduct a system inspection. This course is approved for Texas Real Estate Commission (TREC) continuing education credits.

In Fiscal Year 2020, NCTCOG will look to host a similar training for inspectors and will create educational materials, such as brochures, mailers, and handouts, that are directed towards homeowners, real estate agents, and home inspectors and their responsibilities related to OSSFs.


