MILITARY OPERATING AREA OUTREACH EFFORTS

The 2018 Joint Land Use Study recommended additional outreach on noise impacts in affected communities underlying Military Operating Areas and Military Training Routes. During the study, outreach conducted in the MOAs indicated broad and general support for military operations. A few areas had noise complaints, which generally picked up once operations resumed after a deployment. Mostly residents in the MOAs were interested in finding out more about what training operations were occurring in the areas.

Project staff indicated this recommendation at a meeting with the previous Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Fort Worth Commanding Officer. This CO had initiated an electronic newsletter, the Lone Star Flyer, to interested parties about base activities. The CO indicated a willingness to add public officials in the MOAs to the distribution list and to add information specific to the MOAs to the newsletter. Four issues of the newsletter (**Appendices 1, 2, 3 and 4**) have been distributed to date with this information included and sent to the MOA officials.

Project staff will monitor this moving forward and assist with any updated contact information for public officials as requested by the base.


