The Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) has reviewed the DFW 2023 Transportation Conformity report and supporting documents for the current Mobility 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), developed by the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG).

NCTCOG serves as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, Lewisville-Denton and McKinney-Frisco urbanized areas acting through the Regional Transportation Council (RTC). The MPO along with TXDOT, reviewed, discussed, and submitted responses to comments received from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) during the conformity review process.
