NCTCOG spoke about the history of the regional stormwater monitoring program leading up to the current permit term. NCTCOG then briefed the Task Force on the recent approval from the NCTCOG Executive Board to allow the NCTCOG to move forward with the Regional Stormwater Monitoring Program and enter into a contract with the Consultant, Atkins North America, Inc., on behalf of the participating entities. NCTCOG spoke on the changes made to the Letter of Authorization (LOA) and the addition of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA). NCTCOG mentioned the next steps are for the NCTCOG to send the ILA and LOA to the entities for review and approval. The signed agreements would allow NCTCOG to sign a contract with Atkins and execute the Notice to Proceed. Lastly, NCTCOG confirmed the Task Force approved the budget and their individual cost-share amounts.

Atkins was chosen as the Consultant for the Stormwater Monitoring Project
through the procurement process by the Task Force. Atkins will begin
meeting with cities individually to choose the sampling sites and conduct
