
NCTCOG will provide an overview of the Regional Plan and Burns and McDonnell, Inc. will inform the group on the status of the update of the Regional Plan.



Survey Provides Key Data for RSWMP

- ▶ Burns & McDonnell developed a Survey to collect data from municipalities on various solid waste and resource recovery topics
- ▶ For the past six weeks, municipalities have been encouraged via email list blasts, direct emails, and phone calls to complete the Survey
- ▶ Due to the importance of having as many NCTCOG municipalities provide perspective as possible for the RSWMP, **the Survey deadline has been extended to this Friday, February 19**
