9. Implications to Mobility 2050 Based on New Demographics

Action Possible Action Information Minutes : 15

Presenter: Dan Kessler and Brendon Wheeler, NCTCOG

Item Summary: Staff will provide a report regarding efforts to develop the next Metropolitan Transportation Plan, Mobility 2050, including approaches to integrating the new demographic forecast, public perceptions and needs, and policy considerations.

Background: Federal guidelines require the Dallas-Fort Worth region to update the long-range transportation plan a minimum of every 4 years and to look at least 20 years into the future. In addition, Mobility 2050 must demonstrate federal Transportation Conformity. The updated plan will include a new financial plan, updated demographics and technical analysis, updated project recommendation listings, and robust public involvement. Regional Control Totals were shared with the Regional Transportation Council in June. NCTCOG Research and Information Systems and Transportation staff have completed an analysis and modeled a forecast for 2050 Population and Employment throughout the region, which is currently under local review. The implications of this forecast on the transportation system will be presented.
