

Council approved Ord 26196-06-2023 allowing TPW ROW Inspection staff to issue citations for Contractors for violations	6/13/23
Judge approved 6 Citation "Action Codes"	7/14/23
TPW met with Stakeholders to share info re: Citation Program	9/9/23
Program started	10/1/23
First citation issued	12/18/23



85205P	WORKING IN THE RIGHT OF WAY – FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH PERMIT RESTRICTIONS OR REQUIREMENTS	FWCC 30-20(a)(2)
85206P	WORKING IN THE RIGHT OF WAY – DAMAGE TO PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS, OR ALLEYS	FWCC 30-20(b)(1)






Citations (10/01/23 - 9/04/25)






Citations by Utility Providers
