Item Summary:	Staff will provide an update on the development of Mobility 2050, the region's next Metropolitan Transportation Plan. The presentation will include an overview of ongoing efforts and progress toward completing the plan with updates on key plan elements.		
Background:	Federal guidelines require the Dallas-Fort Worth region to update its long-range transportation plan at least every four years and forecast transportation needs at least 20 years into the future. Mobility 2050 will build on the region's previous plans by incorporating updated demographic forecasts, financial projections, technical analyses, and public input to guide the development of transportation projects, programs, and policies. The plan must comply with federal requirements to ensure it is financially constrained and aligns with transportation planning regulations. Mobility 2050 will serve as a critical blueprint for shaping the region's multimodal transportation system in the coming decades.
