SUBJECT: Request for Proposals for Predictive Crash Analysis Software

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is requesting written proposals from qualified firms(s) to provide a crash analysis software license or tool which will aid the region's roadway safety improvement candidate selection processes and roadway safety plans by proactively identifying higher than expected or higher than predicted crash risk at intersections or along roadway segments throughout the North Central Texas region. The crash analysis software must incorporate the predictive crash methods documented in the most recent edition of the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials' Highway Safety Manual.

This is an invitation to respond to the Request for Proposals (RFP). Proposers must submit one hard copy or one flash drive of the submission to Sonya Landrum, Program Manager, 616 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, Texas 76011. Flash drives that are unreadable or contain corrupted files will be considered non-responsive. **Proposals must be received by 5:00 pm, Central Time, on Friday, April 11, 2025.** Proposals received after that time will not be considered and will be returned unopened. The in-hand submittal will count as the official submittal. In addition to the in-hand submittal, NCTCOG is requesting electronic submission of proposals to TransRFPs@nctcog.org. Electronic submissions only will **not** be evaluated. The RFP will be available at www.nctcog.org/rfp by the close of business on **Friday, March 14, 2025.**
