# FY 2020 Additional Funding Priorities

<b>Priority 1 – 3</b>	Fund first three Bomb Suit projects on EOD priority list
<b>Priority 4 – 5</b>	Fund next two Night Vision projects on SWAT priority list
<b>Priority 6</b>	Fund additional \$20,000 to Training & Exercise for regional trainings
<b>Priority 7</b>	Fund remaining SWAT night vision projects on SWAT priority list

# Statewide Emergency Radio Infrastructure (SERI) Grant

HB 2952: To support state and regional efforts to improve or sustain interoperable emergency radio infrastructure. Projects must enhance current capabilities or address capability gaps identified by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) or Texas Interoperable Communications Coalition (TxICC) in either the Texas Statewide Communications Interoperability Plan (SCIP) or DPS Report on Interoperable Communication to the Texas Legislature.

- Only COGs can apply and will hold the funds
- Applications due in eGrants by March 12, 2020
- Period of Performance: September 1, 2020 - August 31, 2022
