Certified Stormwater Inspector-Construction Dallas, TX on December 5, 2018

Construction stormwater permits have a requirement for the inspector to be qualified. This course applies to stormwater construction inspectors for both industry and government. The course focus is on inspector duties, responsibilities, and authority. It begins with the stormwater regulations and permits and is followed by a detailed discussion of how to perform an inspection. This course also covers construction best management practices (BMP) that work, and those that do not work. Participants receive the presentation, regulations, permit, SWPPP template and an erosion & sediment control manual all on a thumb drive.

This one day course focuses on permit compliance as the key to avoiding stormwater fines and penalties.

Testing will be conducted; students are required to achieve a minimum overall score of 75% to be awarded .6 CEUs (Continuing Education Units) from the National Stormwater Center, and a five (5) year Stormwater Inspector Certificate.



Fred Heitman will be your instructor for this training.

Fred conducted training for EPA and State NPDES managers under a threeyear contract, which was managed by John Whitescarver. Fred was previously the Director of Water Enforcement for the State of Oklahoma and currently lives in Tennessee.

Pricing, Registration, Terms - Dallas, TX on December 5, 2018

This course is \$399 per person plus \$25 registration fee, for a total of \$424 per person. There is a \$25 per person discount for 2 or more registrations from the same organization. .6 CEUs awarded by National Stormwater Center for successful completion.

<u>Terms:</u> Certificates of Training valid for 5 years and CEUs awarded by National Stormwater Center will be issued to attendees who achieve a minimum of 75% accuracy on overall testing. Class fees are refundable if cancellation is received 7 days prior to start date. Registration fees are non-refundable. Substitutions are allowed with notification to our business office. In order for the training to be conducted there must be a minimum of seven attendees registered. The deadline for registration is ten business days prior to the first day of training.
