3. **Project Discussion.** NCTCOG will request feedback from the subcommittee on potential projects for FY2021. Attendees will have the opportunity to discuss the updated description of the Stormwater Technical Subcommittee.

Attendees discussed potential projects for FY2021 and agreed on creating an educational explainer video to educate the public on TMDLs, their purpose, sources of bacteria in waterways, and other aspects. After the completion of this video, members will evaluate the need for topic-specific educational explainer videos.

The Stormwater Technical Subcommittee's updated description was approved by attendees. The new description will be included in meeting correspondence and on the subcommittee's webpage.

4. **NCTCOG Updates and Roundtable Discussion.** NCTCOG will provide general updates and members will have an opportunity to share what is happening in their communities.

- NCTCOG is coordinating a TMDL Calculations Workshop for April 2021. This virtual workshop will include a presentation from Jimmy Millican, TIAER, and from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Jimmy Millican's presentation will cover how to calculate waste load allocations, load duration curves, and flow data; TCEQ's presentation will cover TMDL benchmarks for stormwater permits.

- The Trinity Coalition and UTRA recently received an award for their work on the Trinity River Water Quality Report Card. They were also successful in receiving designation as a National Recreation Trail for the Trinity River Paddling Trail. Tarrant County is working to gather information for the MS4 annual report and is waiting on approval from TCEQ on their MS4 SWMP.

DART requested feedback from other attendees on the electronic submission of Phase II reports as compared to paper reports.

City of Denton has received confirmation that the technical review of their SWMP has been completed, and their official letter of approval is forthcoming.
