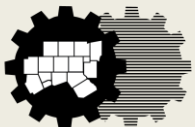

About the TAIT Tool

- Transit Accessibility Improvement Tool highlights demographic groups who may be more likely than others to rely on public transit services to meet their daily needs
- National Cooperative Highway Research Program (NCHRP) Report 532, Effective Methods for Environmental Justice Assessment

TAIT LAYER

- Percent of the population below poverty (also referred to as low income)
- Percent of the population with a disability
- Percent of the population age 65 and over

Symbology	Relationship to TAIT Variables Regional Percentage
No Color	\leq Regional Percentage for All Variables
Gray	$>$ Regional Percentage for One Variable
Mauve	$>$ Regional Percentage for Two Variables
Purple	$>$ Regional Percentage for Three Variables

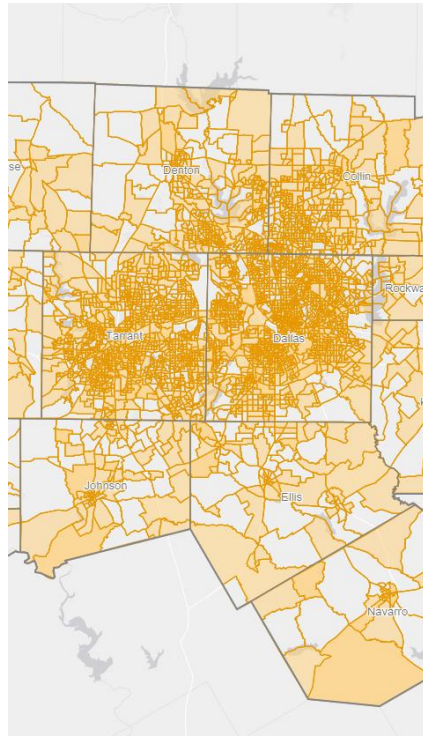

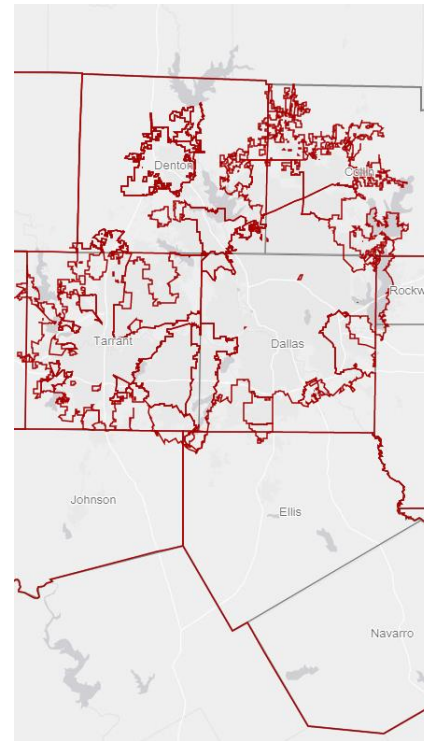

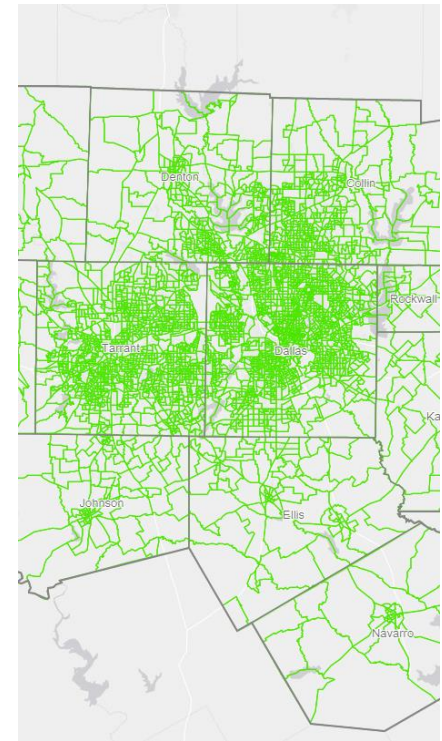
Population
