

Cops crack down on inspection stickers

Expired and counterfeit stickers are the target

CEDAR PARK, Texas (KXAN) - Cops in Williamson County are cracking down on expired and counterfeit vehicle inspection stickers.

If they catch drivers with bad tabs, they're pulling drivers over and writing tickets.

Their goal is to reduce air pollution by pulling cars that don't pass emissions tests off the streets.

"Certainly, it is a growing problem, especially in our area with the growth that we have here," said Williamson County Constables Office Lt. Deputy Roy Fikac. "I do know that over 500,000 Americans die each year across the nation as a result of air pollution."
