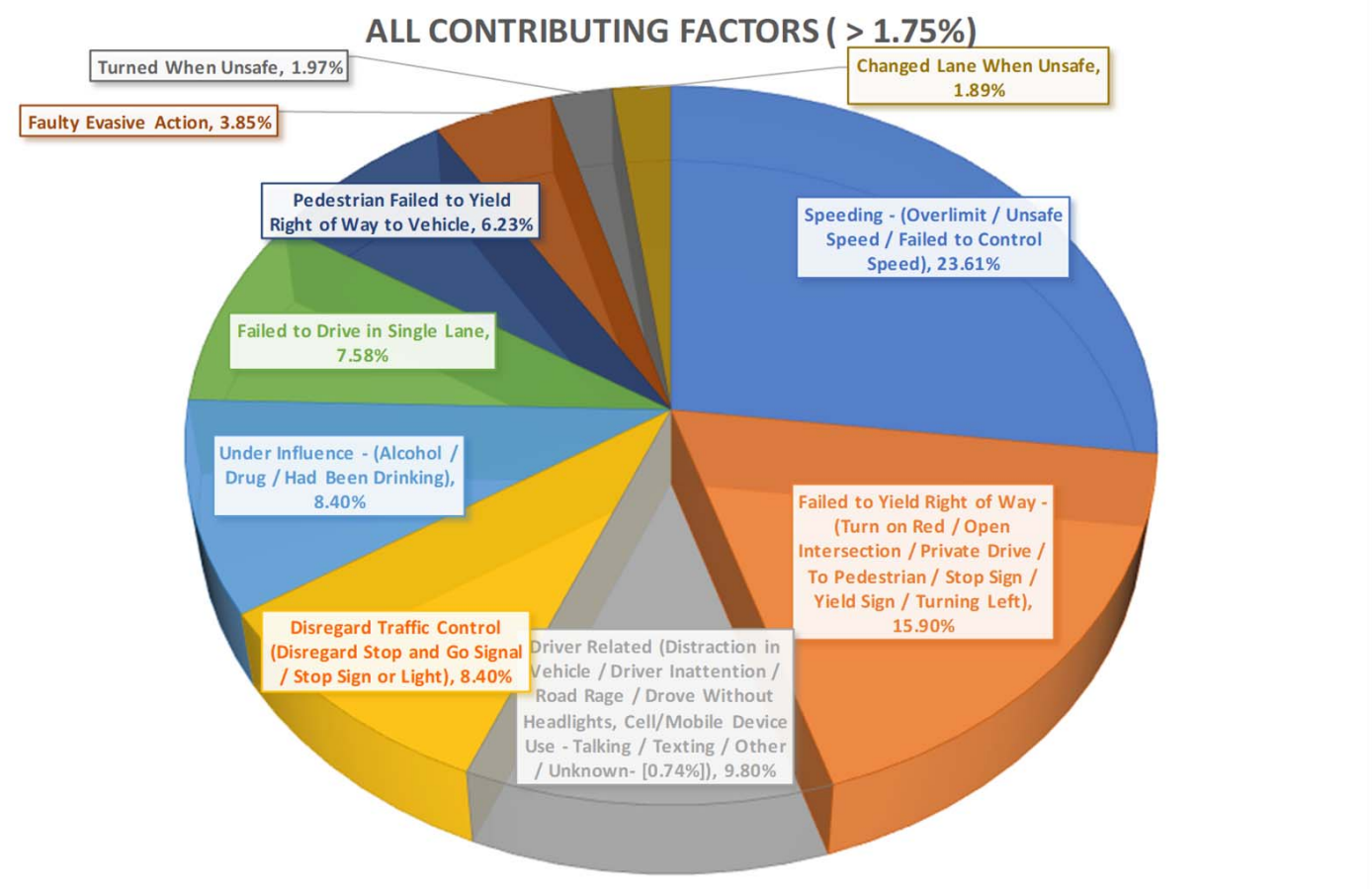

Notes:  
 1. Roadways considered to be "non-limited access facilities" are of type: Business, Farm to Market, Principle Arterial, Park Road, State Loop, and State Spur  
 2. The number of "occurrences" is not equivalent to the number of "crashes" in this analysis, as more than one 'contributing factor' can be listed for each 'crash'.  
 3. The Contributing Factor Analysis above includes Primary, Secondary, and Tertiary Contributing Crash Factors on limited access facilities in the NCTCOG 12-County MPA.  
 4. This analysis does not take into account the contributing factor values of 'None' or 'Not Entered', which accounts for 41.00% (1,829 occurrences) of 'all contributing factor' records received.  
 5. This summary analyzes the crashes used in developing the crash rate which account for the following 12 counties: Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant, and Wise Counties.  
 6. An Injury is classified as "serious" if it is of type: Incapacitating (Suspected Serious Injury)
